Day 9 DURANGO-NARROW-GAUGE RAILROAD-SILVERTON-GLENWOOD SPRINGS

DURANGO Scenic train trip on the Durango & Silverton Narrow-Gauge Railroad through San Juan Mountains en route to Silverton.

SILVERTON Free time to explore before a scenic drive to Glenwood Springs.

GLENWOOD SPRINGS Overnight stay at Globus Local FavoriteGlobus Local Favorite Hotel Colorado. Free time this evening. B

Day 10 GLENWOOD SPRINGS-GEORGETOWN LOOP RAILROAD-DENVER

GLENWOOD SPRINGS Scenic drive through the Rocky Mountains en route to Georgetown. GEORGETOWN Scenic train ride on the Georgetown Loop Railroad.
